# Renovation Van der Pekbuurt



Plans renovation houses and planning




In February we sent you a newsletter with the message that the plans of the renovation were delayed. To improve the quality of your house certain improvements are necessary. And the costs of those improvements were very high. This would mean that we could no longer do other things, such as renovations of other houses in other neighborhoods.

This year we further researched how we could make it possible that your house gets the renovation it deserves and we found a solution. We initially thought that all of foundations needed repairing. This would cost a lot of money. However, the repairing of the foundations is not necessary for all houses. In this newsletter you can read what our plans are, and when this will take place.



#### What is the plan

- The houses will be renovated.
- The outside will be refurbished.
- The houses will be better insulated
- The inside lay out of the house may be changed.
- The gas supply will be removed from the houses. In the kitchen you will cook electric.
- Ymere will make plans together with the residents to make the gardens greener.



# Everyone can return after renovation


- You can return to your house after renovation.
- If you don't want to move back, you can move to another renovated house in de Van der Pekbuurt.
- Or you can choose to find a house outside the Van der Pekbuurt. You will get priority (Stadsvernieuwingsurgentie).

#### This is how we do it

- Ymere will renovate 100 houses at the time. So it will take approximately 12 years before all houses are renovated. Unfortunately we can not renovate all 1123 houses at the time.
- If your house need repairs, which cannot wait until the renovation, they will be done. In the beginning of next year you will receive more information on that subject.
- Ymere will work together with the residents to make a plan for renovations.
- In 2023 we will start with the renovation of a small amount of 8 houses on the Hagedoornweg.
- At the start of 2024 the renovation of the of the 'yellow' group of houses will begin (see map on the next page).

# **General Planning**

The Van der Pekbuurt has a large number of houses. Therefor we have divided the neighborhood into separate groups. Each group has a color.

The year of the start of the renovation of each color is mentioned in the circles. The planning depends on the speed of the renovations. Two years before the start of the renovation, you will be personally informed by Ymere by letter.


#### Your opinion is important
