Plan for renovation positively reviewed by the Huurdersvereniging

The Huurdersvereniging Van der Pekbuurt has reviewed the general renovation plan and was positive over the majority of the plan.

- Compensation for moving
- Preference for communal gardens
- Layout houses
- Public space
- Rent increase after renovation

Advise from the Huurdersvereniging

We also received advise. For example about removing the bayonet chamber. Many tenants of the ground floor apartments would like to keep the little room upstairs. We are researching the possibility for keeping the room. Tenants who agree to to remove the bayonet chamber will receive discount on the rent.

These houses will be the first to be renovated. We have explained to the tenants of these houses the options for (temporarily) moving and/or returning to their renovated home.

And what it means to not have gas. Questions were also asked such as 'Can I come back after the renovation?', 'Can I still pay the rent?' and 'What will happen to the gardens and greenery in the neighborhood?'

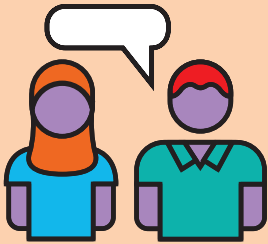
